At Elm Plating, your safety is our top priority! We are in the process of updating our **Lockout/Tagout (LOTO) procedures** to protect everyone while working with machinery and electrical equipment. Here's what you need to know:

🔧 **Only trained and authorized employees** can perform maintenance, repairs, or electrical work—always ensuring machines are in a **zero-energy state** before starting.

⚠ **LOTO in Action:** Authorized employees follow **Lockout/Tagout procedures** to block energy flow before working on equipment. This prevents unexpected startups and keeps everyone safe!

👷 **If you operate equipment, you play a role too!** Understand the purpose and importance of LOTO—it's in place to protect YOU.

🚫 **NEVER remove a lock or tag!** If equipment is locked or tagged out, that means it's unsafe to use. **DO NOT attempt to restart or reenergize it.**

💡 **Tags are warnings, not locks.** They don't physically prevent startup, so don't rely on them alone! Make sure they're clearly written, securely attached, and easy to understand.

🤝 **Together, we create a safer workplace.** Follow LOTO procedures, stay informed, and look out for one another! If you have any questions, **ask your supervisor or safety team.** Safety first—always! 🔒 ✅
